## FIRE SAFETY CIRCULAR

To All Tenants

## FIRES CAUSED BY UNATTENDED COOKING

Lately, there has been an increasing trend of kitchen fires caused by unattended cooking. We seek your cooperation in preventing such fires. A Service Charge will be issued to any tenant found negligent.

- 2. The general guidelines when observing kitchen fire safety includes:
  - i) Do not leave pans unattended. Turn off the heat if you have to leave the kitchen;
  - ii) Do not use matches or lighters to light gas cookers, please use spark devices which are safer;
  - iii) Take care if you are wearing loose clothing as this may easily catch fire;
  - iv) Keep the oven, hob and grill clean. Build-up of fat and grease may ignite easily;
  - v) Keep electrical leads, towels away from the cooker;
  - vi) Ensure that kitchen suppression system is serviced annually; and
  - vii) Do not use water to extinguish fires caused by cooking oil use the dry powder fire extinguisher instead.
