VEHICLE FIRES AND SMOKE INCIDENTS IN CHANGI AIRPORT

Any vehicle fire or smoke incident especially in the apron area can cause disruption to aerodrome operations in Changi Airport. In serious circumstances, injuries or death could be the resultant.

- AES urges all ground handlers to enhance the regular maintenance of their vehicles, particularly the heavily utilized tow-tugs and tractors to prevent fire related incidents involving these vehicles.
- 3 Due to the increasing numbers of vehicle fires and smoke incidents occurring in Changi Airport, AES shall now levy a service charge for any fire related incident caused by the negligence of the ground handler.
