FIRE SAFETY CIRCULAR

To Airport Staff and Partners

OBSERVANCE OF FIRE SAFETY DURING FESTIVAL PRAYERS FOR THE SEVENTH MONTH OF THE LUNAR CALENDAR

As the Seventh Month Festival nears, we wish to take this opportunity to gently remind adherents that there shall be no indiscriminate and unattended burning of joss sticks, incense papers, oils, candles etc within Changi Airport, particularly <u>within</u> <u>buildings and at the airside</u>. The burning of these items poses as a potential ignition source and may cause fires.

- 2. You are therefore requested to observe the following fire safety measures:
 - i) Burning is strictly prohibited within buildings and at the airside;
 - Burning at the landside shall only be done from 7 August 2013 to 4 September 2013 at the <u>five</u> designated areas as shown in Annex A;
 - iii) Burning of incense paper shall be carried out using a non-combustible container provided with a cover.
 - iv) Fire extinguishers shall be provided at the burning sites.
