## MAINTENANCE OF FIRE SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Recently, our AES inspectors had reported an increasing number of fire safety infringements amongst tenanted premises involving the non-maintenance of fire fighting equipment. AES would like to take this opportunity to stress to airport tenants on the importance of servicing of fire safety equipment. Fire-fighting first aid equipment (e.g. fire extinguishers and hose reels) and egress aiding devices (e.g. exit lights, emergency lights) are to be serviced diligently as spelt out in the Tenancy Agreement and Fire Safety Manual.

- 2 These equipment are important in the event of a fire in providing early intervention to incipient fires. Failure to maintain such equipment may result in dire consequences such as fire spiralling beyond control and resulting in loss of human lives and damage to property.
