FIRE PREVENTION CIRCULAR

To All CAG Staff and Stakeholders,

Fire Safety Declaration of P&FM Storage [Petroleum and Flammable Liquids]

It was observed that there was a rising trend of illegal and improper storage of P&FM in CAG leased premises. These improper or illegal storages pose additional fire risk to the airport community.

- A serious fire outbreak could occur due to inappropriate storage location or storage equipment. The volatility and flammability nature of P&FM would also cause a quick escalation of the size and spread of a fire.
- We appreciate your effort in maintaining a high level of fire safety standard at Changi Airport and hope that good fire safety culture can be practiced within your organisation. We would expect tenants to be responsible for proper house-keeping in their respective premises and reporting of any improper acts to the relevant authorities.
