## FIRE PREVENTION CIRCULAR

To Airport Staff and Partners,

## PROHIBITION ON ILLEGAL STORAGE OR OBSTRUCTION TO FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT

Fire-fighting equipment such as fire hosereels and fire extinguishers must be easily accessible for quick extinguishment of incipient fires.

- The illegal storage of non fire-fighting materials, and obstruction to fire-fighting equipment, prevents direct access to the fire-fighting equipment. This could result in escalation of fire.
- Below are some examples of illegal storages and obstructions:

Non fire-fighting materials found stored or obstructing access to fire-Fighting equipment will be disposed. In addition, the owners will be liable to a service charge of up to \$1,500 Excl GST.
