## FIRE PREVENTION CIRCULAR

To All F&B Operators

## COMPLIANCE WITH KITCHEN FIRE SAFETY [PREVENTING UNATTENDED COOKING]

This circular serves to notify all F&B operators recent kitchen fire incidents, caused by unattended cooking took place at Changi Airport vicinity and in other establishments. AES would like to remind all operators that such negligence not only leads to unnecessary fire alarm activations, disrupting airport operations, but also poses a risk to the safety of the public and the airport community.

AES strongly caution F&B operators to strictly adhere to kitchen fire safety protocols, particularly in preventing unattended cooking. Below is the aftermath of fire sprinkler activation due to unattended cooking. The operators were forced to halt their operations, resulting in loss of income, and they also face service charges.





- In addition, AES mandates F&B operators to conduct monthly assessments of their supervisors and kitchen staff regarding kitchen fire safety. Records of these assessments must be kept for a minimum of two years and be readily available to AES upon request.
